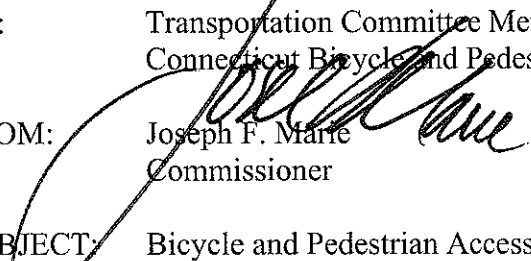

SUBJECT: Bicycle and Pedestrian Access Transportation Project List

Pursuant to Section 3 of Public Act 09-154, An Act Improving Bicycle and Pedestrian Access, please find attached a list of transportation projects that contain bicycle and pedestrian access.

The Department of Transportation (Department) identified forty-one projects awarded in Fiscal Year 2009 that include elements for pedestrians or bicyclists, such as sidewalks, audible pedestrian signals, push buttons, signs, pedestrian/bicycle trails, and ramps. Total dollars being expended for these items equals \$9.9 million, which was 1.9 percent of total funds awarded for the construction, maintenance and repair of roads in the State. The data set used for this posting covers state Fiscal Year 2009 (7/1/2008 through 6/30/2009), and includes state and municipal projects awarded during the period, with completion dates projected before December 2012. While the attached represents what the Department believes to be a conservative list of identifiable expenses made for bicycle and pedestrian accommodations, it is important to note there are other types of accommodations made to projects during the normal course of planning and engineering that benefit all users (e.g. increasing the shoulder width of a road through line striping).

The Department has also added a bicycle and pedestrian performance measure as part of our annual Performance Measures Metrics Report. This measure will track the percent and total amount of dollars spent and/or programmed to be spent, on projects containing items that improve accessibility for pedestrians and bicyclists.
